Psalms 127

I. Work can be a worthless _____. (Psalms 127:1-2; Matthew 6:31-32)

*Whatever you do, work at it with all your heart, as working for the Lord,
not for human masters, - Colossians 3:23 (NIV)*

II. The visual _____. (Psalms 127:3-5)

- A. God gives a graphic picture of his blessing to those who keep Him in focus.
- B. Two Considerations.
 - 1. God says children are a heritage from the Lord.
 - 2. We also see in children, God, provides us with everything we are striving for.

III. Some help for the _____.

- A. So how do we break the cycle? How do we get from the obsession to just a profession?
 - 1. Evaluate... take a good look at what you are doing and why.
 - 2. Communicate ... Let it be known that your family comes first.
 - 3. Eliminate ... what you can.
 - 4. Meditate ... take time to meet with God. Matt 11:28-30
 - 5. Recreate ... Find a hobby, a sport, something fun.
 - 6. Vegetate ... Remember the Sabbath principle.
